












Feasibility Study Scope of Work

Project Orientation and Inventory

The overall Corridor's extents and boundaries, topography and steep slopes, surrounding land use and recreational resources (trails, campgrounds), primary habitat areas, and watersheds.

Economic Feasibility and Advising

Broad overview of the demand for and potential use of the trail.

Legal Feasibility Assessment

Initial research of ownership and identification of potential fatal flaws

Corridor Condition Inventory and Assessment

Summarize key findings of existing assessments and identify areas requiring further study.

Trail Governance, Operation, and Maintenance

Explore options for operations and maintenance and potential roles for public, non-public agencies, local communities, recreation and resources advocates, and areas for in-kind contributions from involved entities.

Acquisition and Financial Feasibility

Draft Study Report due Steering Committee in October
